Dear Parents,

Wellington's Summer Childcare is available for Wellington students **ages 4 through rising fourth grade**. This childcare will be offered for five weeks beginning **July 6th and ending August 7th from 8:30 a.m. - 4 p.m.** Families may register for one week or several weeks, but all reservations would be on a first come, first serve basis as space is limited; no drop-ins will be permitted. The weekly rate for the care is \$250 per child. Children will be expected to bring their own snacks and lunches.

Wellington's Summer Child Care program will include structured activities and free play, organized games, lots of outdoor time either on the playground, field or in open spaces. Summer childcare will include themed activities that should not be considered as enrichment, but may be enrichment based. Scavenger hunts, crafts, and walking field trips will be part of our weekly schedule. Age groupings will be mixed as we will place siblings together.

Summer Childcare Protocols

We are happy to welcome back our families this summer and want you to know that we have put safeguards in place under the direction of the CDC and Ohio Department of Health to protect you and your child.

This is what we ask you to do:

For your child: watch for symptoms of COVID-19 such as sore throat, cough, fever, headache, runny nose, and difficulty breathing. If he or she is running a fever of 100 degrees or more, your child should remain home and stay home until after 24 hours without a fever without taking pain relievers.

Take your child's temperature every morning and let us know upon drop off what his or her temperature is that day.

Make sure you (or another responsible adult) are available should we need to call you.

Follow the curbside dropoff and pickup procedures of your child's group that week. (see below)

Wear a mask should you need to enter the building.

This is what we will do:

Teachers will have a temperature check every morning.

Each group will be nine students or less; siblings will be grouped with each other.

Have a dedicated classroom each week per group. Limit mixing of groups. Classrooms will be sanitized at end of every week.

Adult teachers will wear a mask in the school.

Have your child wash hands upon arrival and before departure.

Make sure that toys are sanitized each week prior to the next group using them. (or daily if sharing during the day)

Have separate art supplies for each child so no sharing is necessary.

Have separate inside and outside recreational spaces for each group as much as possible.

What your child should bring:

A non-refrigeratable packed lunch and snacks. These cannot be shared with classmates.

A water bottle

A mask (which will be worn when moving through inside hallways or public spaces)

A towel

Extra clothing (just in case!)

A blanket or a cuddly for quiet time

Curbside pickup directions:

Teachers will be waiting at the curb for your child between 8:25 and 8:30 am every day and will have your child ready for pick-up between 3:55 and 4:00 pm. We ask that you not get out of your car unless you are wearing a mask. Should you need to drop off your child later than 8:30 am or pickup earlier than 3:55 pm, please call and leave a message at 614.324.1648.

The following are possible drop off and pickup locations. You will be informed prior to the start of childcare where you will be dropping off and picking up your child.

- Drop off and pickup at curb near events entrance.
- Drop off and pickup at curb near dining room entrance
- Drop off and pickup at curb outside of library/Sokol store
