

FACT: Per-pupil funding in public schools has gone up in recent years. 8.9% increase from 2011 to 2018.






# **FACT:**

Vouchers save tax dollars since vouchers are always 10—50% less than per-pupil funding at public schools.

**MYTH#5** 

FACT: Non-public schools are held to a higher standard. 'Choice' schools face consequences after 2 years of D/Fgrades. Public schools can receive4yearsofanFgrade before required intervention.





Indiana's Choice Scholarship Program is for low-and middle-income families. Almost 70% of students receiving vouchers qualify for federal free or reduced lunch.

FACT: Choice has helped diversify non-public schools. More than 41.57% of voucher recipients are nonwhite.

NON-PUBLIC PUBLIC

FACT: Non-public schools consistently out-perform public schools on standardized tests.
