GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Under the direction of the Program Manager and Project Lead the incumbent will:

Oversee all aspects of conformance with the FDA Manufactured Food Regulatory Program Standards.

Develop, update, and maintain policies, procedures and SOP's associated with a high-quality food inspection program. Organize, conduct, and oversee required food safety training of current and future food inspection staff.

Conduct FDA Contract and wholesale food and cosmetic inspections. Conduct food inspection field audits of staff conducting FDA contract food manufacturing inspections. Attend comprehensive training programs in the areas of manufactured food safety and environmental health. Prepare technical grant deliverables and maintains communication with FDA MFRPS support staff. Represent the Department at appropriate meetings, conferences, workshops, etc.

NOTE: Candidates that posess experience in strategic planning, evaluation and implementation are encouraged to apply. Individuals who posess a Registered Environmental Health Specialist license issued by the NJDOH are preferred.

REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree supplemented by a Master's degree in Biology, Biochemistry, Ecology, Epidemiology, Toxicology, Physics, Industrial Hygiene, or other related science.

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of experience in work involving evaluating health effects resulting from environmental exposures.

Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
