Survey Summary

From March 18, 2021 to March 31, 2021, the Louisiana Federation for Children conducted a survey to evaluate the level of parental satisfaction with the Louisiana Scholarship Program (formally known as the Student Scholarships for Educational Excellence Program).

The Louisiana Department of Education reported 6,141 students were enrolled in the Louisiana Scholarship Program during the 2020-2021 school year. 4,331 surveys were emailed to parents who have one or more children enrolled in the program. 913 parents participated in the survey – a 21.1 percent return rate.

Survey Sample

This year's survey sample includes at least one survey from 111 of the 130 participating schools. Respondents attending schools in 28 of Louisiana's 64 parishes are represented in the survey sample. Of the surveys received, 17.3 percent are from parents of first-time scholarship recipients, with the remaining 82.7 percent representing parents of continuing students.

Major Findings

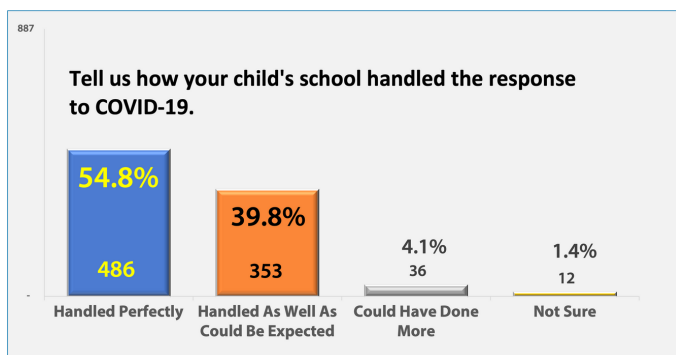
- **94.6% of parents participating in the Louisiana Scholarship Program said their scholarship school handled COVID-19 perfectly or as well as could be expected.**
- **91.0% of parents are very satisfied or satisfied with their child's current scholarship school.**
- **92.9% of parents are happy with their child's academic progress at his/her scholarship school.**
- **97.8% of parents say their child feels safe in his/her scholarship school.**
- **96.9% of parents say they and their children feel welcome at their child's current scholarship school.**



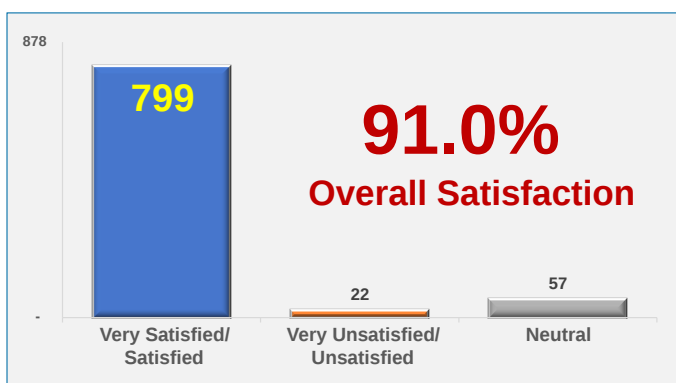

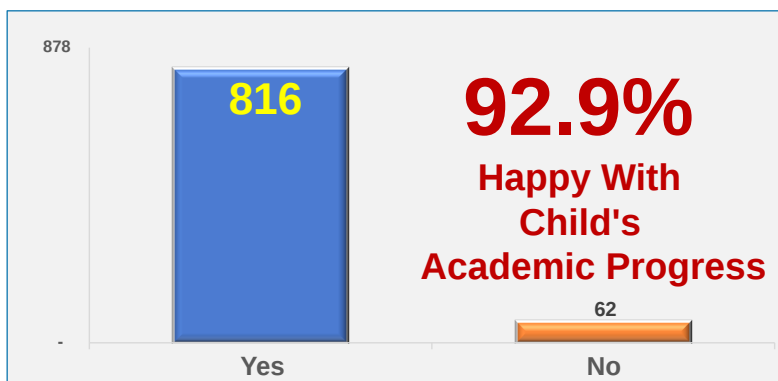
Tell us how your child's scholarship school handled the response to COVID-19.



Overall, how satisfied are you with your child's scholarship school?



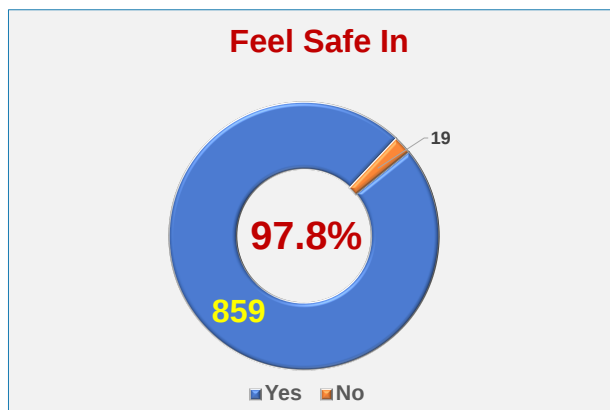
Are you happy with your child's academic progress at his/her scholarship school?



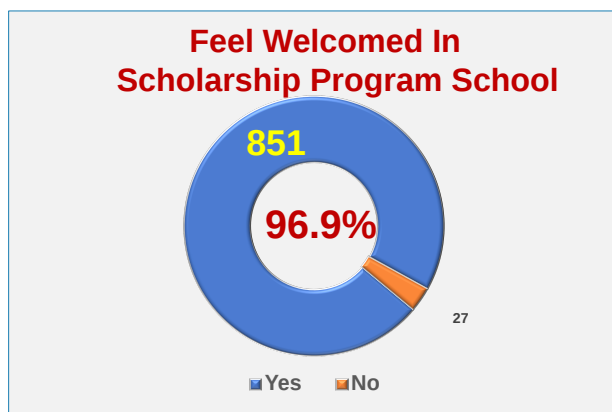
