

- Proposed increase of \$1,000 could bring UCPS state ranking up to 10th


Local Supplement Increase – School Nurses / Psychologist / Social Worker

FY 2021 Budget Breakdown




FY 2021 State Budget Breakdown






FY 2021 Local Budget Breakdown






FY 2021 Budgeted Revenues by Source






UCPS & Charter Student Enrollment
