Income Eligibility Continued Support for Scholarship Families

Build, Learn, Grow Scholarship applications for early childhood education programs are now closed, and scholarships for enrolled families end on June 30, 2022. The Office of Early Childhood and Out-of-School Learning (OECOSL) is providing temporary CCDF eligibility to approximately 6,600 families who qualified to receive maximum support available through the scholarship program (i.e., received tuition support at the 80% level).

To be eligible to transition to CCDF assistance, families must be currently enrolled in the *Build*, *Learn, Grow* Scholarship program, currently attending an early childhood program and have household income at or below 85% of State Median Income. Please use the chart below to determine if a family's income qualifies for this temporary assistance.

Note: To help easily identify eligible families, programs should have received a list of qualifying children in the announcement of this opportunity.
