### 2 Submit a public comment.

### 3. Write a personal letter to comment on the proposed public rule.

You may submit a comment online and send a letter by mail. To count, the letter must reference: "DHS/EOIR; RIN 1125-AA94; EOIR Docket No. 18-0002." The letter must be postmarked by July 15, 2020.
