

- A question came up concerning lanai enclosure and sign and seal issues: Kirsten requested that the member send a couple of examples where lanai enclosures were rejected, and she will look into this issue and report back to CBIA.
- Summer remodels appear to be up about 20% from last year. Rich Long mentioned they have a couple of new staff members coming on board.
- Rich Long shared they are grappling with NOC's because there is no mechanism to alert staff when NOC's have been uploaded in the initial permit packet. The process is designed for NOC's to be uploaded to conditions after the permit is issued. Until they can rectify the problem, Rich requested that members upload NOC's to conditions and not when the initial permit is submitted until the issue is resolved.
- A member shared a concern when he uploaded his new contractor registration; they did not appear on the portal, nor did he receive confirmation of receipt. Rich will check with Ken and get back to CBIA.
- Also brought up by a member was the charge for registration with Collier County. The County staff clarified the fee is for using the electronic system, not for the registration.
