All LPISD students and employees are required to self-screen before entering a campus/department each day. If you are unable to pass the self-screener, call the school nurse or supervisor for guidance prior to coming to the campus/work that day. Employees are to also call the Human Resources Department at (281) 604-7112.

The LPISD employee self-screening form is posted on the Human Resources webpage. The student self-screening form is posted on the Parents webpage.

Positive COVID-19 Test or Symptomatic and Awaiting a Test Result

Students or employees who test positive for COVID-19 are to stay home for 5 days from the onset of symptoms (or from the date of a positive test, if asymptomatic).

If after 5 days the student/staff member is fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication, and symptoms are improving, or there were never symptoms, the student/staff member may return to school/work.

District Testing Program

La Porte ISD will no longer offer the district testing program at this time, due to new requirements. Fortunately, COVID-19 tests are readily available in our community.
