

Region 1 Planning Council (RPC) is a special-purpose, regional government agency designated to coordinate intergovernmental collaboration. This regional model provides an efficient means to promoting a well-informed, comprehensive dialogue that holistically addresses regional issues by fulfilling the needs of government entities for long-range planning, securing funding, and analyzing and providing data in support of regional projects and initiatives.

Essential to fulfilling its purpose as a planning commission, RPC is a designated metropolitan planning organization (MPO), representative economic development district (EDD), geographic information system (GIS), and land bank authority (LBA). Services also include community health, economic development assistance, fund development, research, and analytics.
