GI Bill Students:

Are you planning to study in a foreign country?
Learn how to use your VA education benefits
outside of the U.S.



There are three ways to study in a foreign country using the GI Bill:

- 1 Enroll at a foreign campus of your school that is GI Bill approved.
- 2 Enroll in a study abroad program at your school that is approved for GI Bill funding.
- 3 Enroll directly at a foreign university that is GI Bill approved.

Eligibility:

- You must be enrolled **more than ½ time** to receive a Monthly Housing Allowance (MHA).
- You must be enrolled in **courses** that will **apply to your degree program**.

VA will pay for:

- Tuition and fees.
- Books and supplies.
- MHA.

VA will not pay for:

- Airfare or amenity fees.
- Any fees not charged to all students in your program, such as fees directly related to a study abroad program.
