Van Aken District: Christ Church is nestled within one of the most exciting and impressive areas of Cleveland, the Van Aken District. [The Van Aken District](#) is the largest single construction project in Shaker Heights history. The planning took years of public and private partnerships to transform the auto-oriented location around the Cleveland RTA terminal into a pedestrian-centric, transit-oriented retail development. This 7-acre, vibrant, walkable getaway serves a population of over 200,000 people and is a destination for nearly half a million people living in greater Cleveland. New retail and housing developments are still being added, and the area is growing in every way.

Cleveland: [Cleveland](#) is a vibrant city, rich in cultural heritage. We are home to three professional sports teams (Guardians, Cavaliers, and the Browns) and two major universities (Cleveland State University and Case-Western Reserve University). Many diverse cultures call Cleveland home, coming together in pride in our city. Highlights include superb music for all tastes, featuring the Cleveland Symphony Orchestra and the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame, as well as a beautiful network of Cleveland metroparks rich in hiking trails taking you from the shores of Lake Erie, to the Cleveland Metroparks Zoo, the Cleveland Cultural Gardens and nearby Cuyahoga Valley National Park. Our hospitals are recognized throughout the world for their excellence. Our theater district, Playhouse Square, is the largest performing arts center in the US, outside of New York City. The best part of Cleveland is our people - full of grit, warmth, a sense of humor (we are perpetual underdogs after all), and kindness.



The Diocese of Ohio



The Diocese of Ohio was formed in 1817 as the first diocese established beyond the 13 colonies. It consists of 80 congregations stretching across the 48 counties in the northern half of Ohio. The diocesan offices are located within Trinity Cathedral, Cleveland, just ten miles away from Christ Church.

In 2017, the Diocese dedicated Bellwether Farm in Wakeman Township, near the demographic center of the diocese. Bellwether is a camp, conference, and retreat center situated on an organic, regenerative farm designed to foster innovative community and educational partnerships.

We are led by our 12th Bishop, the Rt. Rev. Anne B. Jolly. Serving in the Diocese of Ohio means that you join with a visionary, engaged bishop who is inspiring us to be more faithful, healthy, effective, and sustainable followers of Jesus Christ in our unique contexts.
